

Taster Tally

The Taster Tally is a counter that can be used to count customers. It can be incremented by the cashier or set up in specific products to increment the counter automatically. In the Taster Tally Maintenance area, you will be able to see a breakdown of what hours the tallies were recorded.

The most common uses are to either have the cashier record all customers that come into a tasting room, or have the tasting product increment the count automatically and not have the cashiers record everyone. It all depends on what information your winery is looking to capture. Recording a tally can be accessed by the Taster Tally button if displayed on the cashier screen or as a selection under the Process menu.

Since it is not part of a sale, VinNOW allows you to enter the Taster Tally and record customers without having to exiting the Cashier screen or an existing sale. Each cash register has its own tally. Taster Tally is accessed through a displayed button on the cashier screen, in the Process menu, or by pressing F6.

Taster tally totals are displayed on the Business Summary report. The report displays the total count tallied and the average sale amount based on the total count.

Taster Tally Maintenance is located in the back office maintenance menu.

- 1) Select the desired date.
- 2) The left grid is populated with a list of PC cash register workstations which had open shifts on the date selected. The right column also shows the total number of tasters for each PC cash register workstation on the date selects. The first column in the grid to the left is the check mark column. The tasters by hour report on the right will display the information on whichever active register was checked on the left. To view a different registers hourly report just check to the left of that register.
- 3) To edit the taster counts, click in the row next to the desired register workstation to display a check mark and display the hourly taster counts in the right grid

- 4) In the right grid type in the hourly tasting counts as desired.
- 5) Click "OK", to update the PC cash register hourly taster counts just changed.

Note: It is important to remember that if you have your cashiers counting all customers that come through the door that you not set up your tasting products to also increment the counter or your totals will be overstated.
